



**Margins Wine | 2023 Muscat blanc | Cecchini Ranch
Contra Costa County**

Varietal: 100% Muscat blanc

Brix at harvest: 19.5

Vinification:

40% of the grapes in the final blend were destemmed and skin fermented for two days with one punchdown per day. The other 60% of the grapes were whole cluster pressed the day of picking. The two blends were aged separately in neutral oak for five months and blended before bottling. No fining, no filtration, and no other modifications or additions except 30 ppm of sulfur dioxide the week before bottling.

Bio:

The vines sit on clay loam soils in flat and sunny eastern Contra Costa County, with a stellar view of Mt. Diablo in the distance. Erggelet Brothers farmed and managed this property from 2017-2021 with a strong emphasis on organic practices, soil building, livestock integration, and minimal intervention. The vineyard changed ownership in 2022, but continues to be farmed organically.
